

This online course provides individuals with an introduction to working in the plumbing-heating-cooling industry. During this six-module course, participants learn what is required to pursue a career in the construction industry as well as key skills and techniques to help them succeed.

Offered though the PHCC Academy[®], this course was created by the PHCC Educational Foundation and developed by Adam Manley, PhD., Associate Professor of Career and Technical Education at Western Michigan University.

Also offered through the PHCC Academy, the Plumbing Pre-Apprentice online educational course is an affordable introductory course designed to help entry-level plumbing workers be productive as helpers and assist in determining an appropriate career training path. The course offers an in-depth introduction into plumbing definitions & principles, customer service & soft skills, safety, science & math, plumbing systems & products and troubleshooting fixtures & gas. During this seven-module course, participants will learn how to pursue a career in the plumbing industry, as well as key skills and techniques to help them succeed.

- Students must complete the 7-module course in 4 months (120 days).

Plumbing Apprenticeship | Classroom or Online

The PHCC GA Academy Plumbing Apprenticeship Program is approved by the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Apprenticeship. Apprentices can be registered into the DOL's Rapids System based on contractor's needs (optional). Program provides apprentices a thorough understanding of the plumbing trade and prepares them to take the Georgia State Plumbing Licensing Exam to become Journeyman Plumbers in four years.

Fast Track to Service Plumbing™ | Online Only

Train technicians to be "truck-ready" in record time. the **PHCC National Educational Foundation's Fast Track to Service Plumbing** trains technicians in a self-paced and focused manor to be running in their own truck within 12-18 months or sooner (based on time and enthusiasm).

Designed for contractors by contractors, this comprehensive entry-level training is best for residential or commercial plumbing service and repair contractors. Supervisors receive a guide with suggested training activities.

This self-paced course includes 33 modules critical to the success of today's plumbing service and repair professionals. Topics include safety, customer service, plumbing and electrical work, basic business skills, and more.

Fast Track Students receive a Certificate of Achievement per module from the PHCC National Educational Foundation.

The PHCC GA Academy HVACR Apprenticeship Program is designed to provide a working knowledge of the latest tools, equipment and technologies for an HVACR technician to successfully fulfill his roles at a licensed contractor shop. It provides superior hands-on information needed to successfully maintain and troubleshoot today's complex heating, air conditioning, and refrigeration systems. 
- Support the advancement of your technicians based on your needs.

- Complete regular reviews with PHCC GA Academy to ensure delivery of program curriculum.

Enroll apprentices in the U.S. Department of Labor Registered Apprenticeship Program to meet your company's eligibility for prevailing wage projects. PHCC GA Academy administrators register and help track On-the-Job Training (OJT) hours. This option includes:

- Registering apprentices into the DOL/BAT Apprenticeship Partners Information Data (RAPID) System.
- Generation of Apprenticeship 671 Form (optional for E-Learning Programs).
- Credited OJT Hours Worksheet and generation of the Davis Bacon Certificate.





Enrollment Checklist



Apprentice / Applicant Eligibility and Responsibility:

- Must be at least 18 years of age to enroll.
- Must be able to read and comprehend basic 8th grade English and math to achieve success in our programs.
- Must adhere to student guidelines set forth in each program.
- Must show proof of achieving a high school education or equivalent before completing any program to receive a Certificate of Completion.
- Additionally, for in-person classroom programs:
 - First-time enrollments are assessed an entrance exam fee of \$150 (waived for active PHCC members).
 - Students must achieve a passing grade of 70% or greater on exams (see below).
 - No schedule changes or transfers allowed after third week of program.
 - Additionally, for U.S. Department of Labor Apprenticeship Program enrollments:
 - Must have valid driver's license at time of enrollment for on-the-job training requirements (DOL).
 - Abide by U.S. Department of Labor standards and guidelines throughout program.
 - Students must submit completed/approved OJT Hours Form each month of program.

Sponsoring Contractor / Employer Responsibility

- Identify your company as the source of financial responsibilifor tuition and fees to PHCC GA Academy and pay all tuition fees and dues upon enrollment of student/s.
- Acknowledge receipt and accept contents of PHCC GA Academy Apprenticeship Standards.
- Accept and sign PHCC GA Academy "Employer Acceptance Agreement".
- Ensure student participation by allotting necessary time off for student to complete program within set schedules.

Enrollment Process:

- Submit completed application and receive confirmation within 24-48 hours.
- Application received by PHCC GA Academy administrative staff and invoice generated.
- Tuition payment is received in full by administrative staff.
- Enrollment process begins.
